- Counseling for couples, individuals, families, groups, at-risk children, and neglect. (Sliding fee scale offered, bi-lingual therapist available)

475 People served using therapeutic interventions

- Caring Parents (Prevention of shaken baby/Abusive Head Trauma including presentations)

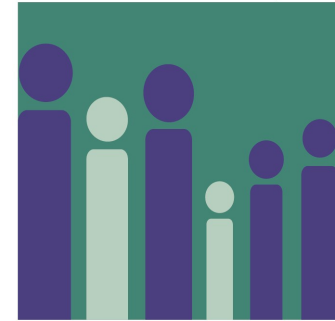

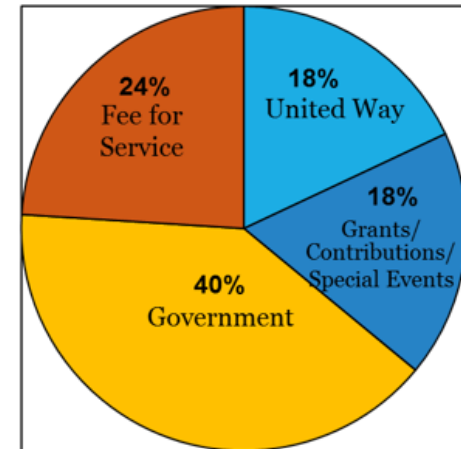

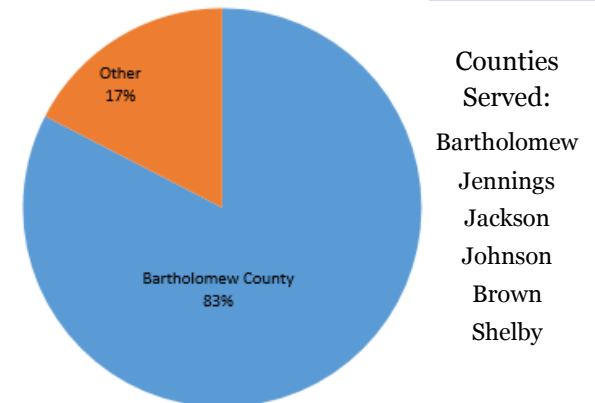


2015 Household Income
