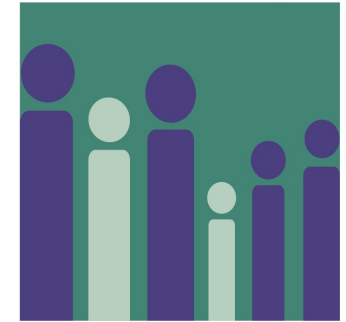

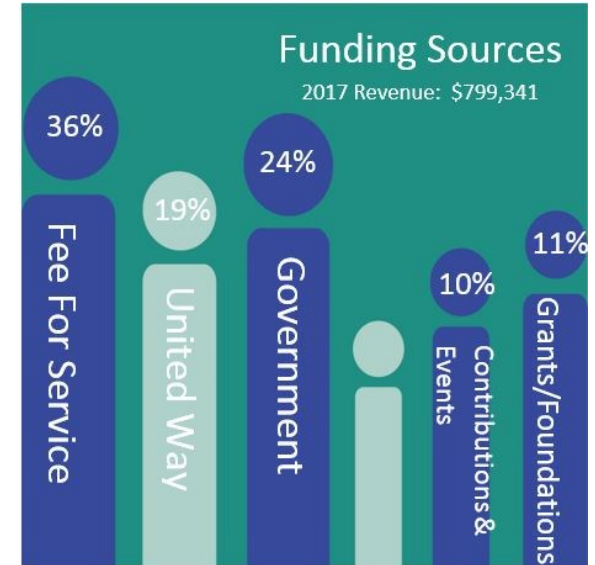

CAP (Child Abuse Prevention) Adult Prom

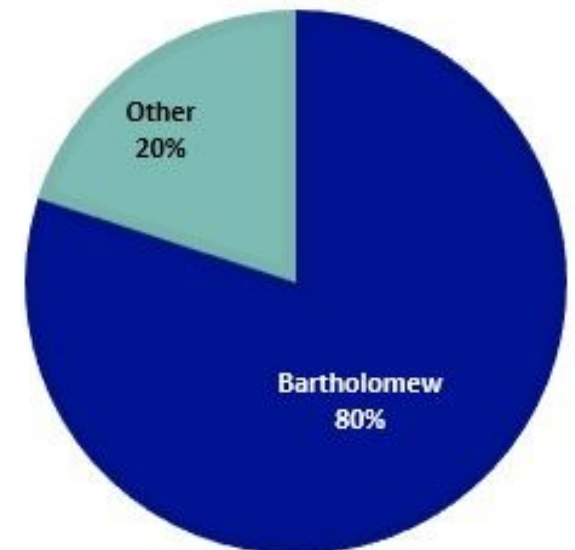
